[Erasmus Dashboard](#): A web application that makes the lives of university staff easier by digitising administrative procedures.

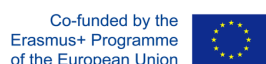

We value candidates with:

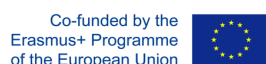
