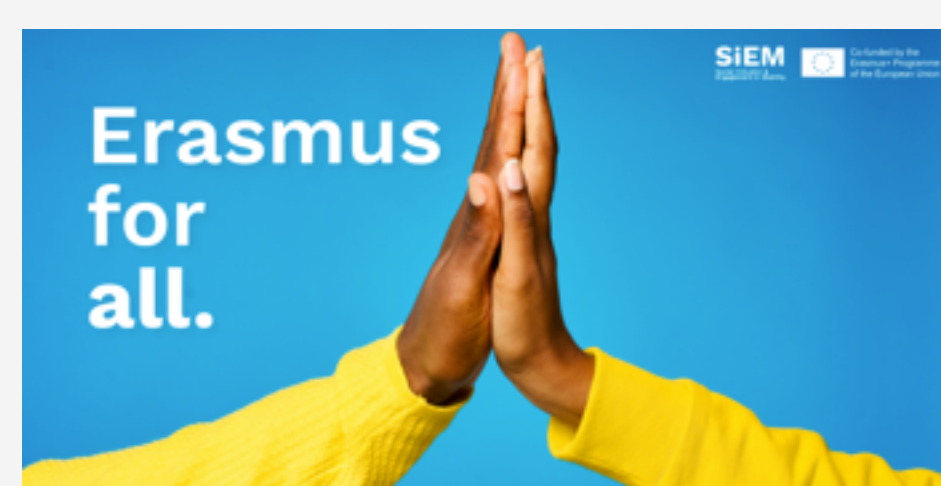

New Erasmus Goes Digital webinar series.

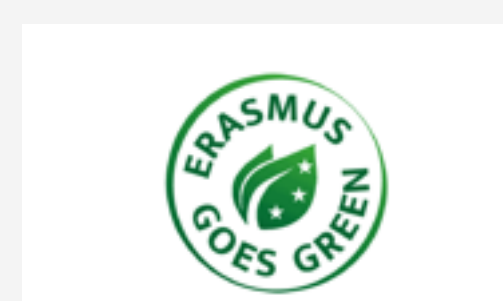

Social inclusion in mobility.



Inclusion is a priority for the next Erasmus+ programme, but very little hard data is available on the accessibility of the current programme and what measures could be put in place to improve access and participation. Both these aspects are at the heart of the Social Inclusion & Engagement in Mobility (SIEM) KA3 project. The project team has recently published [findings](#) and recommendations from a research that gathered feedback from over 12,000 students and 750 staff members in Europe, as well as set of [guidelines](#) designed to support universities.

Erasmus Goes Green report.

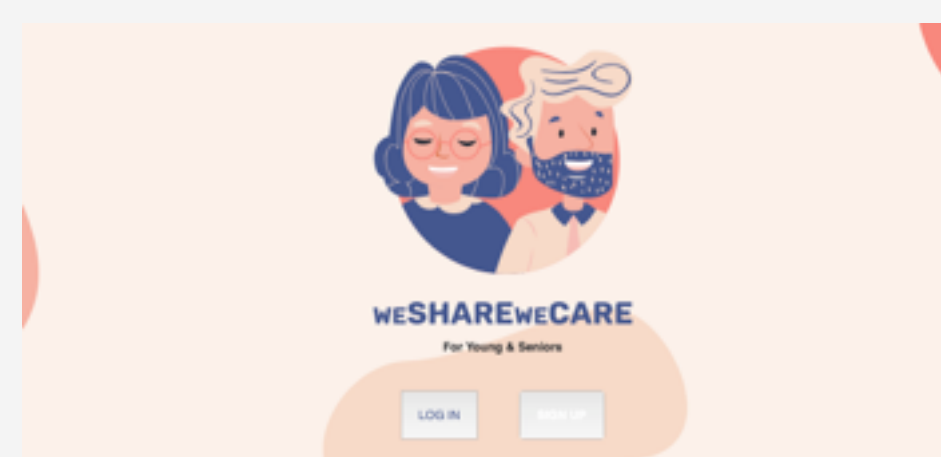

Launch of the WeShareWeCare platform.



On April 29th, during the European Day of Solidarity between Generations, the WeShareWeCare consortium successfully launched the first version of its [online platform](#). The platform aims at connecting international students and seniors through homesharing opportunities and intercultural and intergenerational activities organised by local associations. The platform is available in English, Spanish and French.

New Erasmus+ programme 2021-2027.

The 2021-2027 Erasmus+ programme brings over €26.2 billion to support mobility and cooperation. The role assigned to both the Erasmus Without Paper and the Erasmus+ App marks the first time in the history of the programme when infrastructure developed and operated by universities is embedded in its functional fabric.
