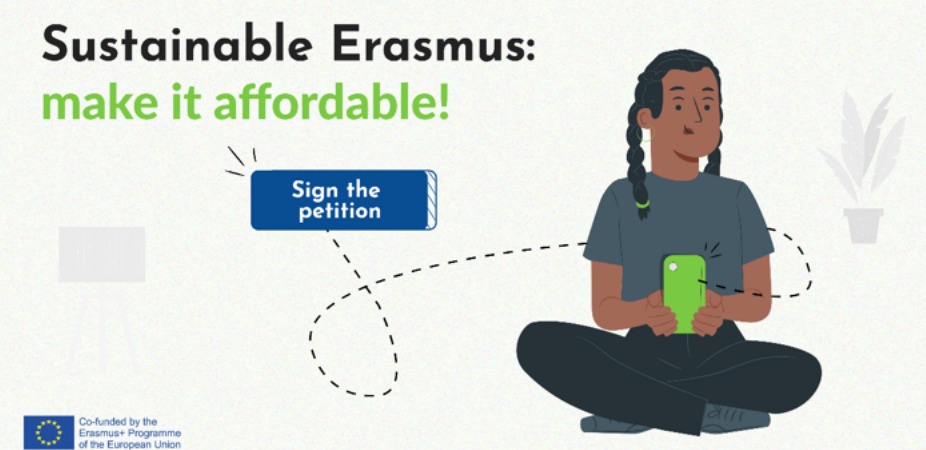




Meet the newest members of the network!

The European Commission has set up [new guidelines](#) on fast-tracking recognition of Ukrainian academic qualifications, thus helping to make the most of the skills, knowledge and abilities of the title holders. Additionally, a Eurydice [report](#) summarises key policies and measures, developed by top-level education authorities across Europe, aiming to assist higher education institutions (HEIs) in integrating refugee learners from Ukraine.
