Six months into the war that has shaken Europe, we have released a new statement, together with the European Students' Union (ESU) and the Erasmus Student Network (ESN), calling the European Commission to increase the funds for the Erasmus+ programme for the academic year 2022/2023.

We believe that the start of the academic year demands urgent financial action in order to support higher education institutions in welcoming all Ukrainian students. What is more, the Erasmus+ programme can be strategically used to prevent brain drain from Ukrainian higher education institutions by formally maintaining the enrolment of Ukrainian students at their home institution and using Erasmus+ as a mobility scholarship for the time of their forced stay abroad. The Erasmus+ App thus far.


